Teaching repertoire piano solo:

Since 2002, I have taught all types of styles, from etudes and technical exercises (Hanon, Cortot, Brahms ...) to sonatas, concerts and bigger works by all sorts of composers. It is impossible to make a comprehensive list of exactly which repertoire, as much has taken place on courses, masterclasses, privately.

In addition to the repertoire I have actively performed (see repertoire list), I have an extended, and continuous in-depth study of the piano literature for teaching purposes. I also have a broad specialisation in the Spanish piano literature, and a special relationship to the Hungarian and Norwegian repertoire, covering a wide range of composers of great importance in the piano literature.

I feel confident in all kinds of styles, and have an ability to quickly recognise technical and musical problems both in the performer / student, and at the first reading of the score if the repertoire is unknown to me. I also have a great orchestral knowledge, and often find links and themes between different works that are worth knowing for the student. I have never kept a list of the piano literature I have been teaching.
